This policy is not intended as a stand-alone policy, and it will be reviewed periodically.

1. Recognize that the chief function of the Cancer Fighters at all times is to serve the best interests of our mission and values.
2. Accept as a personal duty the responsibility to keep up to date on emerging issues impacting our mission and values to conduct ourselves with professional competence, fairness, impartiality, efficiency, and effectiveness.
3. Accept as a personal duty to be fiducially responsible and up to date on the budget.
4. Respect the structure and responsibilities of the board, provide them with facts and advice as a basis for their making policy decisions, and uphold the bylaws and implement policies adopted by the board and membership.
5. Conduct board business with positive leadership exemplified by open communication, creativity, dedication, and compassion as stated in our mission and values.
6. Respect and protect privileged information to which we have access in the course of our official duties.
7. Strive for personal and professional excellence and encourage the professional development of others.
